



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
Parliamentary Review asked
"Why has change not happened?"

It mostly confirmed existing approach,
offered some new concepts and changes:

- Quadruple Aim
- New models of care
- Seamless health and social care
- National leadership and direction
- People at the centre, engage constantly
- Use technology, digital, innovation

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The Plan is a direct response to the Review:

- Based on the Review recommendations
- Endorsed by further stakeholder engagement

Adds to the Review in some areas:

- Add a 'Future Vision'
- Has a broader scope (e.g. funding)
- Links to other policy 'Prosperity for All'
- Applies more structure to Review's thinking
- Puts more emphasis on practical delivery

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Key elements of the plan:



- Clearly defined future vision which brings together health and social care, prevention
- Focus on Regional Partnership Boards to create space for change
- Transformation Programme responsible for implementing the plan
- Transformation Fund to accelerate 'new models of seamless local health and care'
- Design Principles to simplify complex policy requirements


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Primary Care Model
