




Global landscape of permanent roaming regulations








Navigating a fragmented regulatory landscape

Insights from 65 countries

No single compliance strategy fits all

SIM registration is expanding beyond B2C



Authorisation and notification requirements are evolving

Shared and extraterritorial numbering plans (+901, +882, foreign E.164) face regulatory barriers or time limits in several jurisdictions
