THE COMPANY

The Mountain West Conference (MW) is a collegiate athletic conference affiliated with the NCAA. From its inception in 1999, the MW has been committed to excellence in intercollegiate athletics, while promoting the academic missions of its member institutions. Progressive in its approach, the MW continues to cultivate opportunities for student-athletes to compete at the highest level while fostering academic achievement and sportsmanship.

Now in its 22nd year, the MW has been assertive in its involvement with the NCAA governance structure and has taken a leadership role in the overall administration of intercollegiate athletics.

The MW has marked several achievements during its first 21 years, most notably becoming the first to establish a sports television network dedicated solely to an intercollegiate athletic conference (The Mtn.). The MW also was the first to experiment with the coaches' challenge in the college football instant replay system and was the first non-automatic-qualifying BCS conference to participate in four BCS bowl games, winning three.

- Bills were paid with American Express outside of Sage 300 - or sometimes via manual check printing within Sage300.
- The MW handled check fraud prevention manually, outside the Sage 300 system.

- Intacct can aggregate banks transactions and put them in a list view, then match them up with transactions. This automates the positive pay process.


